ARE YOU ONSIDE?

At Fremont Youth Soccer Club...

We all have a responsibility to ensure that everyone involved in soccer finds it to be a fun, safe and positive experience.

As a parent/relative/supporter, please play your part in the development of the youth player and get onside with long term development; show your support for the player, team, and the club by reading and agreeing to the Fremont YSC Members Agreement. By completing registration and the prompt to accept the agreement, you are demonstrating your understanding and willingness to abide by the following:

Code of Conduct

- Support and motivate all players, including the opposition and encourage my child to do the same. There is to be no coaching from the sideline, and support will be through clapping good play and sportsmanship
- Encourage my child to play by the laws of the game and teach them that they can only do their best
- Never publicly criticize or ridicule my child or another player
- Not to place my child under pressure or push them into unwanted activities, supporting the process of development rather than the outcome of a game
- Not to make inappropriate comments about another player, coach, official, spectator or volunteer on any websites or social networking sites which may bring the game into disrepute.
- Not to interfere with the coach's instructions and not to confuse the players by telling them what to do.
- Show appreciation and support for the coach and match officials
- Respect and not question decisions made by the match officials

- Avoid pressurizing players about winning or losing applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Behave responsibly and never engage in or tolerate the use of foul, abusive, insulting or inappropriate words, behavior or gestures
- Stay on the sideline and in no circumstance, do not approach coaches, or match officials during or after a game with any grievances.

Membership Fees and Cancelations

- The season is a 44-week program, starting in July and finishing the following June. Full schedule can be found online.
- The season fee is broken down into manageable installments, an initial membership fee followed by 11 equal installments. Members have an option to pay for the full season up front.
- Installments are based upon a 4-week training block and are scheduled to be withdrawn monthly from the date of initial payment. **Installment fees are not aligned to specific calendar months.**
- While we would like to have all players complete the full season, we understand circumstances can change. Members may drop out from the program.
- Upon cancelation, members will forfeit one future installment payment. Cancelation will be from the end of the training block in which the Director receives notice of cancelation. E.g. cancel received in week 22, payment of block 21 24 is due along with one forfeit payment.

Any breaches or concerns will be dealt with by the Directors of Coaching, and Executive Director, actions including

- Verbal warning
- Asked to leave the side-line
- Requested to not attend future games
- Required to leave the club, regrettably along with any other dependents
- Subject to a fine and/or suspension from the playing league
